Roll Call (Present):

New Federal and State lodging rate is now \$70.00 and the mileage rate is 58.5 cents per mile. Discussion came up about NIC new exam contract. Some research needs to be

done on how other companies develop their exam. Brenda and Chris were assigned to research Promissor/Pearson Vue and PSI, concerning their test development.
